

Dear Parents,

B”H the Governor has given the green light for day camps to open. With his approval he has put in place a list of guidelines that will be strictly enforced to ensure the safety of our campers and staff. In this letter you will find an outline of how we plan on operating this summer. Please read it carefully.

By sending your child to camp you are agreeing to adhere and accept all information below.

SAFETY PLAN:

SCREENING

1. Daily screening will be performed by the parents each morning before sending your child to camp. This will be done through an automated system that will be monitored by the state. Detailed information will be sent as soon as it becomes available to us.
2. If your child does not pass the screening test, **DO NOT SEND HIM/HER TO CAMP!** Please have in mind the well-being of other children and staff at camp.
3. Campers or staff who run a fever or display any Covid-19 symptoms will be isolated from their group and sent home immediately with a chance that we will refuse re-entry into the camp for the duration of the summer. Refund will not be issued in this case.
4. If a family member of a camper contracts Covid-19 it is possible that the Health Dept may mandate the camper to quarantine.
5. If a camper contracts Covid-19 it is possible that the Health Dept may mandate the camper’s bunk to quarantine.

COVID-19 TESTING

All details regarding Covid testing requirements prior to camp will be shared when it becomes available. We are working with other camps to streamline the process. We do recommend getting tested in the event that the Department of Health mandates it.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT/HYGIENE

1. We will provide masks for our staff in compliance with state guidelines.
2. We will provide hand sanitizers for each bunk.
3. Bathrooms will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.

BUNK/GROUP MAKE-UP

1. Every bunk will have a maximum of 15 campers.
2. Campers will primarily stay with their bunk for bunk activities, special activities, lunch, learning groups/shiur and swim.
3. Bunks will social distance from other campers within state guidelines.
4. Every camper who is in leagues will be part of his/her bunk of 15 or fewer and a league team of 15 or fewer.

SPORTS/ACTIVITIES

Campers will be playing sports and having the same exciting activities this summer with some adjustments to minimize contact. Equipment will be disinfected between activities.

SWIMMING

BH the State is allowing swimming pools to be open this summer so we will have swimming but with smaller groups. The lifeguards will enforce the social distance guidelines.

OFF-SITE TRIPS

Off-site trips are currently on hold pending guidelines and safety factors. If there will be any change we will notify you.

BUSSING/SHUTTLE

1. We will be providing shuttle service. Safety guidelines will be implemented for transport.
2. We are working on alternate methods for those of you who have requested and paid for private transportation. We will reach out to you as soon as possible to confirm.

CARPOOL

Safety guidelines will be implemented for carpool.

REVISED CAMP DATES

Due to the very last minute verdict on camp opening and Dept of Health requirements prior to opening day, we are forced to change the camp dates to **Monday July 6th- Friday August 21st**. We are burdened with many extra expenses because of the state's guidelines so the camp fee will remain the same.

LIMITED SPOTS/REFUNDS

1. Full balance is required upon registration.
2. Spots are very limited. All applications or non-refundable.
3. **Any COVID-19 disruptions or stoppages to camper/camp schedule by the state or Department of Health once camp begins do not lower our expenses; therefore no refunds will be given.**

Each year we as directors enjoy giving the children an environment of wholesome fun. A place where they can learn, play and build friendships. We are so grateful that in a time like this we will be able to bring summer joy to the campers. We ask you to work with us to accept and adhere to these guidelines so we can have a safe and successful summer.
